<p>Kaikōura is a strength focused community</p> <p>All children and young people are engaged in learning – there is no one slipping through the gaps</p> <p>Tertiary opportunities are accessible for Kaikōura residents and external providers have good relationships and see potential in Kaikōura</p> <p>There is a collaborative vision for education/learning in our community, including Runanga, schools, businesses, Kaikōura District Council, NGO's and other community organisations who want to be involved such as external education providers</p> <p>Local people working in local jobs</p>	<p>Te Hā o Mātauranga brokering opportunities for Kaikōura residents and recognizing and supporting other brokers of opportunities within Kaikōura</p> <p>Schools and MOE are supported to engage all students eligible to attend</p> <p>Giving organisations pathways to be collaborative such as the youth collective and 0-5 collective</p> <p>Working intentionally to role model strengths based processes in our interactions with all</p> <p>Being a point of contact for external providers – making their work easier with our local connections</p> <p>Working with the Business Association to identify and source educational opportunities that enhance the understanding of how to nurture and grow staff skills</p>	<p>All 5-16 year olds in Kaikōura are engaged in learning</p> <p>The percentage of Kaikōura residents who know of Te Hā o Mātauranga and what we offer increases to 50% (Kaikōura District Council survey)</p> <p>A collaborative vision for education in Kaikōura is created</p> <p>Tertiary courses are offered face to face in Kaikōura</p> <p>Locals are confident of finding employment locally</p>

<p>Kaikōura is a community where Māori students benefit from seeing their experiences and knowledge reflected in teaching and learning.</p> <p>Te Hā o Mātauranga both operates within, and encourages others to operate within, the concept of Ako. Ako is a reciprocal two way learning approach where learner and teacher learn from each other, and also acknowledges that learner and whanau cannot be separated.</p> <p>There is a wide understanding of Tikanga Māori across Kaikōura, and the community acknowledges and embraces the richness and strengths of Māori cultural connections.</p>	<p>Te Hā o Mātauranga working with whanau and students to make sure the work we do reflects Māori students' knowledge and experiences.</p> <p>Supporting other programmes such as Mana Kohine, Mana Wahine and Bros for Change to provide alternative opportunities that are centered in Te Ao Māori.</p> <p>Encourage and support our schools to provide learning that enables success as Māori.</p> <p>Upskilling Te Hā staff in Te Ao Māori, and particularly in the concept of Ako. Making sure that our environment reflects Māori experiences.</p> <p>Encouraging, supporting and holding events and activities that support our community to experience Te Ao Māori.</p>	<p>Māori students and whanau are happy to come to Te Hā and the activities we provide and report feeling comfortable in our environment.</p> <p>Whanau are leaders of some opportunities.</p> <p>Te Hā staff progress in their journey to learn more about Te Ao Māori.</p>
